 - 2. Evidence in support of a fact or statement; proof.
 - 3. Open declaration or profession, as of faith.
 - B. Definition of witness.
 - 1. To see, hear, or know by personal presence and perception.
 - 2. To bear witness to; testify to; give or afford evidence of.
 - C. Ps. 19:7 "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple."
 - D. Ps. 132:12 "If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore."
 - E. Rev. 19:10 "And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."
 - F. The Word of Our Testimony.
 - 1. Is making the Word of God personal.
 - 2. It is giving force or power to the Word of God; activating the Word of God.
 - 3. It is our confession of faith.

- C. What confession does.
 - 1. Reminds us of Jesus' provisions.
 - **2.** Reminds Satan that he is defeated.

V. WHY THE CONFESSION OF GOD'S WORD WORKS FOR YOU.

- A. It is sowing the seed.
 - 1. Saying something doesn't mean it is going to happen.
 - 2. Yet, many things will never happen unless you say it, because it sets the goal.
- B. It causes faith to come.
- C. The words you speak will either cause faith to come or fear to come.
- D. It renews the mind.
 - Confession of God's Word, speaking in agreement with what God says, causes your mind to be renewed to think like God thinks.
 - 2. Thinking leads to talking; talking leads to walking.
- E. It keeps the answer before you.
 - 1. Praying the problem, fears will grow while you are praying.
 - 2. Praying the answer faith will come.
- F. It sets the law of faith into motion.
