 - 1. Angel appeared at right side of altar--Zacharias feared.
 - 2. Fear not, for thy prayer is heard--shall call his name John.
 - 3. Thou shalt have joy and gladness, and many shall rejoice at his birth.
 - 4. The child shall be great in the sight of the Lord.
 - 5. Filled with Holy Ghost from his mother's womb.
 - 6. Many of children of Israel shall turn to the Lord their God.
 - 7. Shall go in power of Elijah
 - 1. Turn hearts of fathers to the children.
 - 2. Turn the disobedient to the wisdom of the just.
 - 3. To make ready a people prepared for the Lord.
- 2. How shall I know this? (How do I know you're telling me the truth? Prove to me this is right).
 - 1. I am Gabriel that stand in the presence of God and am sent to shew thee these glad tidings.
 - 2. You shall be dumb and not able to speak. People thought he had a vision.
- 3. On the eighth day, at John's circumcision, they called his name Zacharias after his father. (Tradition).
 - 1. Zacharias writes the name John on a writing table.
 - 2. Mouth was opened.
- 4. Zacharias filled with the Holy Ghost and prophesied.
 - 1. (Luke 1:68 KJV) Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,
 - 1. And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:
 - 2. That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant; The oath which he sware to our father Abraham.
 - 3. That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.
