 - 3. He is my refuge and my fortress
 - 4. He shall deliver thee from snare of the fowler
 - 5. Thou shalt not be afraid
 - a. Terror by night (devious attacks)
 - b. Arrow that flieth by day (open attacks)
 - c. Pestilence that walketh in darkness
