- 1. YOU MUST BE BORN AGAIN.
 - 1. Water.
 - 2. Spirit.
 - 3. That which is flesh is flesh; spirit is spirit.
 - 4. As we have borne the image of the earthy so shall we bear the image of the heavenly.
 - 5. What is the image of the heavenly?
 - Whom he foreknew He did predestinate to be conform to the image of his son...
 - 2. Changed into the same image from glory to glory.
- 2. EVERYTHING SHOULD BE REFLECTION OF GOD.
 - 1. Order in nature should be a reflection of God.
 - 2. Disorder in nature the result of disharmony with the God of nature.
 - 3. When the peace of God prevails, all his creation will be at peace.
 - 1. The lion and the bear will lie beside a child.
 - 2. The lion and the ox will eat straw together (2 miracles!).
 - 3. That the lion and the ox can co-exit.
 - 4. That the lion is eating straw instead of the ox!
 - 4. "For we know the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now." (Ro. 8:22).
 - 1. Earnest expectation for the manifestation of the sons of God.
 - Creature shall be delivered from bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
- 3. THERE MUST BE A CHANGE.
 - 1. Metamorphoo To change into another form, to transform, to transfigure.

2. Metamorphosis

- 1. Worm to a butterfly.
- 2. Tadpole to a frog.
- 3. Totally different creature.

4. BORN OF INCORRUPTIBLE SEED.

- 1. Take on attributes of God.
- 2. Jesus is the firstborn among many brethren.
 - Jesus is the last of Adam, the beginning of a brand new breed or race.
 - 2 Cor. 5:17 Any man be in Christ he is a new (of a new kind; unprecedented; unheard of) creature.
 - Col 3:10 And have put on the new man which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him.
- 3. We have no resemblance to the person we once were.
 - 1. Totally transformed by the power of God.
 - 2. Not patched over.
 - 3. Not a sinner saved by grace.
 - 4. Not sewing new cloth on a old garment.
 - 5. Not putting new wine in old bottles.

5. WE CAN NOT CHANGE OURSELVES.

- 1. Jer. 13:23 "Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil."
- 2. Though your sins be as scarlet they shall be white as snow.
- 3. That you put on the new man which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
