THE CLEANSING BY THE WORD

John 15:3

- WHAT IS GOD'S WILL IN OUR LIFE?
 - 1. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away.
 - 2. Every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
 - 3. To be pure as he is pure.
- 2. EVERY MAN THAT HATH THIS HOPE PURIFIETH HIMSELF, EVEN AS HE IS PURE.
 - 1. Now are we the sons of God.
 - 2. Doth not yet appear what we shall be.
 - 3. When he shall appear, we shall be like him--for we shall see him as he is.
 - 4. When the Lord shall build up Zion he shall appear in his glory (Ps. 102:16).
- 3. AND THE LORD WHOM YE SEEK SHALL SUDDENLY COME TO HIS TEMPLE.
 - 1. But who may abide the day of his coming?
 - 2. Who shall stand when he appeareth?
 - 3. For he is like a refiner's fire; and like fuller's soap.
 - 1. Shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver.
 - 2. Shall purify the sons of Levi.
 - 3. Purge them as gold and silver.
 - 4. That they may offer unto the Lord an offering n righteousness.

- 4. BUT WE ALL, WITH OPEN FACE, BEHOLDING AS IN A GLASS THE GLORY OF THE LORD.
 - Are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
 - 2. The laver made up of women's looking glasses.
 - But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
 - For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass.
 - 2. For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

5. THE WORD OF GOD HAS A CLEANSING EFFECT.

- 1. "That he might sanctify and cleanse it (the church) with the washing of water by the word. That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that is should be holy and without blemish." (Eph. 5:26).
- 2. "Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you." (Jn. 15:3).
