Ephesians 5:1 - 2 (KJV) 1Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; 2And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

By this shall all men know that you are my disciples that you love one another.
