### 1. FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS AS WE FORGIVE OTHERS

- 1. God forgives
- 2. Man forgives man
- 3. We forgive ourselves

### WHOLE WORK OF REDEMPTION PREDICATED ON FORGIVENESS

- 1. Neither do I condemn you...
- 2. In death he forgave
- 3. God for Christ's sake forgiven you...Eph. 4:32
- In whom we have redemption in his blood, even forgiveness of sins Col. 1:14
- 5. Basis of early church missionary outreach

## 3. FORGIVENESS MEANS THEE WAS BREAKING OF LAW

- 1. Where there is no law, no offence
- 2. Offence cannot be undone, must be forgiven
- 3. Forgiveness always preceded by repentance
  - 1. Goodness of God leadeth to repentance
  - 2. Godly sorrow leadeth to repentance
  - 3. Requires, "I'm sorry"
- 4. Deep-seated pride resists change of mind which admits we are wrong

# 4. FORGIVENESS AND PARDON

- 1. Forgiveness is not pardon
- 2. Pardon does nothing to remit guilt, but only the judgment

- 3. Forgiveness deals with sin; pardon the penalty
- 4. God has not pardoned us, but forgiven us
  - 1. Will not revoke penalty of His law
  - 2. Cannot set condemned man free
  - 3. Full penalty must be paid
  - 4. Jesus was made sin for us
- 5. Story of queen and servant girl
  - 1. I forgive you, but never want to see you again
  - 2. Return to your duties as though nothing had ever happened
- 6. Justification
  - 1. To be declared righteous in a legal sense
  - Does not deal directly with character or conduct, but with guilt and punishment
  - 3. Stand in presence of God in innocence

### 5. FORGIVING OURSELVES

- 1. The heavy load of guilt
- 2. God has forgiven, but can't forgive self
- If don't forgive ourselves, every time persecution, think God is punishing us--think we deserve it
- 4. Healing of memories
  - 1. Memories can haunt
  - 2. Should serve as deterrents to future wrong doing
  - 3. Should remind us to praise and thank God for forgiveness

## 6. FORGIVING OTHERS

- 1. How oft?
- 2. Mark 11:25-26
  - 1. When pray, forgive if have ought
  - 2. If do not forgive, heavenly father will not forgive

- 3. Parable of forgiven servant
- 7. I KNOW MY REDEEMER LIVETH
