 - A. Must know the will of God to do the will of God.
 - B. I delight to do thy will, O God.
 - C. The most important function of our life is to do the will of God.
 - **D.** So much confusion on knowing the will of God.
- II. THE GENERAL WILL OF GOD.
 - A. The will of God to save us and to heal us.
 - B. The will of God for us to serve Him.
 - C. The will of God for us to assemble ourselves together.

V. WHAT ABOUT SPECTACULAR METHODS OF DETERMINING THE WILL OF GOD?

- A. Angel visitations and visions.
- B. Personal prophecies.
- C. Fleeces.
 - 1. Gideon was not ignorant of God's will "If thou deliver Israel through me, as thou hast spoken..."

- a. Not a problem of knowledge, but faith and obedience.
- 2. Fleece setting evidence of doubt, not faith.
 - a. I heard you, but I'm not sure I really believe you.
 - b. Demanding the Lord led me on my terms, not His.
- 3. Fleece setting is dictating to God.
- 4. Fleece setting does not really solve the problem--still element for doubt.

VI. KNOWING THE WILL OF GOD BY THE SPIRIT

- A. Intuition of your own spirit (not always in wind, earthquake, fire...still small voice).
- B. Voice of your own spirit talking to you.
- C. Voice of the Holy Spirit in your spirit.

VII. SOME BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES OF GUIDANCE

- A. Do not panic, if you come to an area in your life and you do not know what to do.
- B. God does not give us guidance as much as He gives us a Guide--fellowship with Jesus.
- C. Guidance is based on principles and precepts of the Word of God.
 - 1. God is more concerned about what I am, than where i am or what I am doing.
- D. Guidance confirmed through indwelling peace of God.
- E. Guidance communicated through desires God gives us.
- F. Guidance comes through godly counsel of others.
 - 1. Be sure of those you seek out are spiritual.
 - 2. Do not ask a lot of people to pray for you or to pray with you.
- G. Don't rush things--God has a time.
- H. Don't get off one horse without another one to get on.
