 - 1. Hot; warmth of spirit; devoted.
 - 2. Serving the Lord with all our hearts; with excitement.
 - 3. Earnest fervent prayer of righteous man availeth much.
 - 4. Rejoicing in hope.

3. PATIENT IN TRIBULATION.

- 1. Ro. 5:3 "...knowing that tribulation worketh patience."
- 4. CONTINUING INSTANT IN PRAYER.
- 5. ATTITUDES OF A TRUE CHRISTIAN.
 - 1. Attitude toward our enemies.
 - 1. Bless them that persecute you; bless and curse not.
 - 2. Recompense no man evil for evil.
 - If thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink--in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.
 - 4. Avenge not yourselves.
 - 1. Give not place unto wrath.
 - 2. Vengeance is mine; I will repay saith the Lord.
