6. He came into the world to save sinners.
7. He came to destroy the works of the devil.
 1. The thief comes to steal, kill, and to destroy.
 2. Jesus has come to bring us life and that more abundantly.

 2. Yea though I walk through the fire, it will not burn me.
 3. Though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, because His rod and staff comforts me.
 9. ***I am a child of the most high King.***
 1. I have royal blood flowing in my veins.
 2. I am destined for the throne.
 3. It is the Father=s good pleasure to give to me the kingdom.
 4. I am an heir of God and a joint-heir with Jesus.
5. I CAN DO WHAT GOD SAYS I CAN DO.
1. ***I can call upon the Lord in my time of need, and He will hear me.***
 1. I cried unto the Lord and He heard me out of His holy hill.
 2. In the time of my distress, I called upon the Lord and He came to rescue me.
 3. As many as shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved (delivered).
 1. Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy upon me.
 2. Lord, if you will, you can make me whole.
 2. ***Satan is no match for me, because greater is He who is in me than he who is in the world.***
 1. I know who lives in me, and I trust Him.
 2. I know who is in the world, and I turn my back on him.
 3. Satan has to flee, because I choose to resist him.
 4. I can triumph over all my enemies.
 1. He has given me power to tread upon scorpions and serpents.
