NEW THINGS I DO

(Isa 42:9 KJV) Behold, the former things are come to pass, and new things do I declare: before they spring forth I tell you of them.

1. A NEW THING I DO.

1. A new thing.

- 1. (Isa 43:19 KJV) Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.
- 2. (Jer 31:22 KJV) How long wilt thou go about, O thou backsliding daughter? for the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man.

2. God desires to do something He's never done before.

- 1. An outpouring such as has never been.
- 2. The latter rain outpouring for the last days.

3. The windows of heaven.

- 1. If the windows of heaven were open, how can it be? (2 Ki 7:1 KJV) Then Elisha said, Hear ye the word of the LORD; Thus saith the LORD, To morrow about this time shall a measure of fine flour be sold for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, in the gate of Samaria. (2 Ki 7:2 KJV) Then a lord on whose hand the king leaned answered the man of God, and said, Behold, if the LORD would make windows in heaven, might this thing be? And he said, Behold, thou shalt see it with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof.
- 2. God is getting ready to open the heavens.
 - 1. Open communication between heaven and earth.
 - 2. Channel of blessings from the Lord.
- 4. A fresh move of God.

2. A FRESH MOVE OF GOD'S SPIRIT.

Not something warmed over, but something new and fresh.

- 1. Not a return to yesterday.
- 2. Not a return to tent revivals or any other previous revival.
- 2. Fresh anointing of God represented by new wine.
- 3. *New wine and new bottles.*
- 3. THE NEW WINE.

1.

- 1. **Pentecostal outpouring.**
 - 1. (Acts 2:13 KJV) Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.
 - 2. (Eph 5:18 KJV) And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

2. Plentifulness.

1. (Prov 3:10 KJV) So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

- 2. (Joel 3:18 KJV) And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall water the valley of Shittim.
- 3. *Found in a cluster.* (Isa 65:8 KJV) Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one saith, Destroy it not; for a blessing is in it: so will I do for my servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all.

4. NEW WINESKINS.

- 1. *New wine in old wineskins*. (Mat 9:17 KJV) Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- 2. New wineskins represent new creatures.
 - 1. (Gal 6:15 KJV) For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature.
 - 2. (Eph 4:24 KJV) And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
 - 3. (Col 3:10 KJV) And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

3. New wineskins represent those who still have elasticity.

- 1. Still can be stretched.
- 2. Open and pliable.

5. NEW CREATURE HAS A NEW NATURE WHICH IS REFLECTED BY A NEW NAME.

1. A new name.

- 1. (Rev 2:17 KJV) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.
- 2. (Rev 3:12 KJV) Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.

2. Change of name denotes change of nature.

- 1. Abram to Abraham.
- 2. Jacob to Israel.
- 3. Saul to Paul.

3. A new nature leads to new confession.

 (Mat 12:34 KJV) O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. (Mat 12:35 KJV) A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.(James 3:9 KJV) Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God. (James 3:10 KJV) Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. (James 3:11 KJV) Doth a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter? (James 3:12 KJV) Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? either a vine, figs? so can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh. (James 3:13 KJV) Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

6. NEW CREATURES SING A NEW SONG.

1. Song of the redeemed.

1. (Rev 14:3 KJV) And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. (Rev 14:4 KJV) These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb.

2. A song of praise to the Lamb.

- 1. (Rev 5:9 KJV) And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; (Rev 5:10 KJV) And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth. (Rev 5:11 KJV) And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; (Rev 5:12 KJV) Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.
- 2. (Psa 149:1 KJV) Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.

3. Song of triumph and victory over the enemy.

- 1. (Psa 98:1 KJV) A Psalm. O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.
- 2. Song of Moses.
 - 1. (Rev 15:3 KJV) And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints.
 - 2. (Exo 15:1 KJV) Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he

hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.

7. NEW CREATURES HAVE A NEW COVENANT.

- 1. (Heb 8:8 KJV) For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: (Heb 8:9 KJV) Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.
- 2. (Heb 8:10 KJV) For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: (Heb 8:11 KJV) And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.
- 3. (Heb 8:12 KJV) For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

8. I MAKE ALL THINGS NEW.

- 1. *All things new.* (Rev 21:5 KJV) And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.
- 2. *New heavens and new earth.*
 - 1. (Isa 65:17 KJV) For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind.
 - 2. (Isa 66:22 KJV) For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain.
 - 3. (2 Pet 3:13 KJV) Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.
 - 4. (Rev 21:1 KJV) And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.
