1. A TRUE SPIRIT OF REVIVAL.

- 1. A spirit of repentance.
- 2. A spirit of humility.
- 3. A spirit of realness--not being one thing and portraying another.
- 4. A spirit of other centeredness (less self-centeredness).
 - 1. A spirit of giving.
 - 1. Giving with no strings attached.
 - 2. Giving because you believe in something.
 - 3. Giving because you love the work of God.
 - 4. Giving with the thought that God is the one who takes note and keeps records.
 - 2. A spirit of reaching out to others in ministry.
 - 3. Find a person and make a difference in their life--Cheering someone else=s life up.
- 5. Serving God out of a true motive.
 - 1. Not serving Him out of restraint.
 - 2. Not serving Him out of fear.
- 2. GIVE EAR O MY PEOPLE.
 - 1. To my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.
 - 2. I will speak that which I have heard and known--which our fathers have told us.
 - 3. We will not hide them from our children--showing the generation to come the praises of the Lord, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done.
 - 4. That the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children.
 - 1. That they might set their hope in God
 - 2. And not forget the works of God.
 - 3. To keep his commandments.
 - 4. And not be stubborn and rebellious as the previous generation.

 - 1. Keeping your vows.
 - 2. Loving and respecting one another.
 - 3. Working as a partnership and not two individuals going in two different directions.

 - 4. Helping kids to feel secure by convincing them that nothing is going to happen to your relationship.
