THE FRUIT OF REVIVAL

How to Judge a True Revival

- 1. OUR DESIRE FOR REVIVAL.
 - 1. We are praying and believing God for revival, and we need to prepare ourselves for it.
 - 1. Recognize it when it comes.
 - 2. Welcome it when it comes.
 - 3. Know the difference between true revival and a distraction.
 - 1. There can be either a counterfeit, which is revealed in contrast to the true. (If there is a counterfeit, you can rest assured there is a real; otherwise it wouldn't be counterfeit).
 - 2. Sometimes a true revival can carry a certain amount of carry-along baggage.
 - 2. The greatest task is to recognize the difference between a genuine move of God and a display of fanaticism or emotionalism.
 - 1. There is a difference between the manifestation of the power and glory of God and emotionalism.
 - 1. Revivals are emotional; no doubt about it. But more importantly, revivals are motivated and engendered by the Holy Spirit.
 - 2. Fanaticism is when emotions take control.
 - (1) not getting too much of God.
 - (2) not being too committed to God.
 - 2. God does nothing without purpose, and He will reveal His purpose if we desire to know.
- 2. REVIVAL COMES BY THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD.
 - 1. You can't make it happen, neither would you want to make it happen.
 - 2. If you made it happen, it would be by your power and design and wouldn't accomplish what needs to be accomplished.
 - 1. A true revival comes by the Spirit of the Lord, not by man's hand.
 - 2. If it came by man, man could will revival at any time, any place.
 - 3. Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit saith the Lord.
- 3. REVIVAL COMES AS THE RESULT OF CERTAIN EFFORTS ON MAN'S PART.
 - 1. Revival comes when people hunger for God.
 - 1. Comes on the heels of a dry spell; after an empty, void place.
 - 1. Comes after a time of seemingly separation from the power of His presence.
 - 2. It's coming out of a desert into a well-watered oasis.
 - 2. Comes when you hunger because there has been little or no manifestation of the power and glory of God. He that hungers and thirsts for righteousness shall be filled.
 - 2. Revival comes when people begin to pray; when people begin to turn to God.

- 1. If my people who are called by my name shall humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways.
- 2. Then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sins, and heal their land.
- 3. There are different levels of revival.
 - 1. I believe the church is experiencing revival now.
 - 2. Yet there is a longing for a greater revelation of Jesus and His glory.
 - 3. There is yet to be an outpouring of God's Spirit upon this earth unparalleled in history.

4. WHAT CAN BE EXPECTED FROM AN OUTPOURING FROM GOD?

- 1. The intent of the church should be two-fold.
 - 1. Ministry to the saints.
 - 2. Ministry to the sinners.
- 2. Purpose of revivals, awakenings, renewals should accommodate these ministries.
- 3. Revival for the church is designed to:
 - 1. Prepare the church for the coming of the Lord and His kingdom.
 - 1. The church must make herself ready.
 - 2. Jesus coming to receive unto Himself a church without spot, wrinkle, or any such thing.
 - 2. Prepare the church for the coming harvest.
 - 3. Mature the body of Christ.
 - 1. The purpose of the former rain.
 - 2. The purpose of the latter rain.
 - 4. Refresh the body of Christ.
 - 1. Times of refreshing.
 - 2. Times of excitement and enthusiasm.
 - 3. Times of great joy.
 - (1) at completion of temple.
 - (2) after Philip's revival in Samaria.
 - (3) after the day of Pentecost even through persecution.
 - (4) great joy can be a fruit of true revival.
 - 5. Revival can be a time of great miracles and healings, but revival should not be just for a demonstration of healings, etc.
 - 1. These should always occur in the congregation of the believers.
 - 2. Lack of healings and miracles indicate a lack of faith in God's Word.
- 4. Revival for the sinners.
 - 1. Usually something has to happen to get the sinner's attention.
 - 1. One of purposes of signs and wonders. Miracles more for believers.
 - 2. The demonstration of the power of the Holy Spirit will draw sinners to salvation.

- 2. A true revival will result in the conviction of sinners.
- 3. A true revival will result in a great harvest of souls, which should rejoice the hearts of the believers.

5. THE FRUIT OF REVIVAL (YOU JUDGE ANYTHING BY ITS FRUIT).

- 1. Any manifestation of a true revival should be scriptural.
- 2. A true revival will bring about <u>change</u>; change which can only come from God; God doing what no one else can do.
 - 1. A change in the saints; a change in the sinners.
 - 2. A change in our individual lives; a change in our families.
 - 3. A change in our church; a change in our community

3. A true revival will perform a deep work of the Holy Spirit.

- 1. Performing an inner work in the inner man.
- 2. Will bring a spirit of conviction.
 - 1. Revealing areas in our life which are not pleasing to God.
 - 2. Search me and know my thoughts, O God. Try me and see if there be any wicked way in me.
- 3. Will manifest a spirit of repentance.
- 4. Will manifest a spirit of humility, recognizing it is God; not giving any man credit.

4. A deeper love and fervency for the Lord.

- 1. A closer, more intimate relationship with the Lord.
- 2. A deeper sense of His presence.
- 3. A higher level of worship flowing forth out of the love of our heart.

5. A greater sense of commitment.

- 1. Commitment to the Lord himself.
 - 1. a greater yearning to do His will.
 - 2. a desire to go or to do what He desires.
 - 3. not my will but thy will be done.
- 2. Commitment to his work.
 - 1. a greater love and commitment to His church.
 - 2. a greater desire to work for Him (we can just love Him, or we can serve Him).
 - 3. The eyes of the Lord roam to and fro to strengthen the hearts of those who are fully committed unto Him.

6. A greater love for your neighbor.

- 1. Different attitude in the way you relate to others.
 - 1. won't be quick to judge them.
 - 2. won't be so ready to condemn, criticize, nor to judge.
 - 3. a spirit of acceptance and forgiveness.
- 2. Make you love everybody!

7. A greater sense of the holiness of God.

1. A true revival should lead to a deeper realization that God is holy and He

- desires a holy people.

 That awareness requires a keener sense of a lifestyle which is pleasing to 2. God.
