- 8. Describe the traditional dispensationalist view of the rapture?
- 9. Why do you think Satan would want to perpetrate the lie of an "any-moment-fly-away-removal-of-the-saints-from-the-earth-rapture?"
- 10. In actuality, what three major events take place at the coming of the Lord according to Paul's writings?
- 11. What are three major timings of the rapture as compared to the Millennium.
