The broad background;

The O.T. Exodus 13, Leviticus 18, Number 13, Deuteronomy 12 = 56 chapters

The N.T. Hebrews 4 chapters for a total of 60 chapters

The scriptural admonish as to study the divine pattern of things to come.

Psalm 29:9b in his temple doth everyone speak of his glory. Psalm 40:6-8 & Matt.5:17 & Matt.11:13 & Lk.24: 27-44 & Acts 26:22 & 1Corn. 10:11 & Rom. 15:4 & Gal. 3:24 & 2 Tim.3:16 & Heb.8-10.

Pattern in the book of Rev. Candlestick 1:12, Laver 4:6, Alter 6:9, Golden Alter 8:3, Ark 11:19.

Define the word “TYPE”:

A foreshadows; that which takes the place in a natural or spiritual pointing to a type.

Examples, John 3:14 & Jo.6:48-51 & 1Corn. 15:46 & Rom.1:20 & Col.2:17 & Heb. 8:1-5.

Define the word “TABERNACLE”

A dwelling place, tent, building, sanctuary, house, structure.

Names of the Tabernacle in the bible;

- a. Ex. 25:9 “tabernacle” dwelling place for God.
- b. Ex. 26:36 “tent” to be temporary, pilgrim aspect.
- c. Ex.25:8 “sanctuary” a place of God’s holiness.
- d. Ex. 33:7 & Ex.40:34-35 “tabernacle of the congregation” & “body of believers”
- e. Ex. 34:26 “the house of the Lord thy God”
- f. Num.1:50 & 9:15 “tabernacle of testimony (witness)” (communion of God)

The need for the tabernacle:

God might dwell among His people to teach His people:

- A) His Holiness
- B) Their Sinfulness
- C) How to approach Him through sacrifice.

The one factor that made the tabernacle different from the heathen temple was the presence of God, His SHEKINAK in the cloud of fire.

The materials for the tabernacle:

Exodus 25:1-7

All the materials were given willingly by all as a free will offering;

- A) Brass (4 tons) judgment, strength, or the Holy Spirit.
- B) Gold (2400 lbs) deity, divine nature the glory of God
- C) PRECIOUS STONE; various gifts and attributes of the Holy Ghost, the glory of the saints.
- D) SHITTIM WOOD; human nature of Christ the Head and Body
- E) BADGER'S SKIN; protection, no beauty
- F) RAM'S SKIN DYED RED; substitution, dedication
- G) GOAT'S HAIR; scape goat, sin offering
- H) FINE LINEN; white for the righteousness of the saints
- I) OIL; Holy Ghost
- J) SPICES for the Anointing Oil; aspect of the anointing
- K) SPICES for the Incense; aspect of the prayer and praise

The silver for the tabernacle:

Ex.30:11-16

8400 lbs. was the offering that was taken from all the male from 20 years and older.

There were about 603,550 men. (Ex.12:37-38)

It was ½ shekel offering given as ransom or atonement money. Jesus shed blood is the required standard of the redemption of all man. It did not matter if the man was rich or poor it was the same for all.

The silver foundation separated the BOARDS and the EARTH. (1Corn. 3:11)

It was used for the FOUNDATION, CAPS, HOOKS, BARS, SOCKETS, and the 2 TRUMPETS.

Christ has ransom or redeemed us by His blood. Redeemed means “to be purchased in a slave market” (MK.10:45, 1CORN.6:20, 1PET.1:8, GAL.3:13 with HOS.13:14)

The workmanship of the tabernacle:

Ex.31:1-11 & 35:1-11 & 36:1-3

It took 9 month to bring the Tabernacle to completion. (Ex. 19:1 7 Num. 9:1)

It took 9 month for the birth of Jesus Christ. (LK.1:30-38 & Heb.10:5-8)

The complete formation of the man-child. (Rev.12:1-5)

The Tabernacle was creative work anointed of God and guided by the Spirit of God. God called two men to be the craftsman for the working of the tabernacle they were Bezaleel and Aholiab filled with the spirit of God in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge and all the manner of workmanship.

There characteristics

Bezaleel (in the shadow or the image of God)

- 1) a type of the Holy Spirit or Jesus Christ, the Firstborn Son
- 2) of the tribe of Judah (praise)
- 3) the son of Uri (light or fiery – divine energy)

Aholiab (tent of my father)

- 1) A type of Jesus Christ, the Five fold ministry Eph. 4:11 in a greater sense the 42nd generation in Ma.1 which will reveal the image, nature, and power to the earth.
- 2) From the tribe of Dan (he that judges)
- 3) The son of Ahisamach (brother of support)

These two men submitted under God to teach others to do cunning workmanship Ex.35:35 Bezaleel and Aholiab devise the curious work of gold, silver, brass, cutting of stones, carving of wood, and to make any manner of cunning work. (The gate, the door, the veil.) The completed work was done and it was set up on the 1st month of the 2nd year on the first day of the month. “Ex. 40:17”

The placement of the camp:

The tabernacle was set up with the Gate to the East. “The Son will arise from the East with righteousness and with healing in His wings.” (Mal.4:2) this nation that had come out of Egypt was in great need of healing. The tabernacle was the meeting for the people and it was in the midst of the camp. There was about 2-3 million people that was set up by Moses. The word camp is a military term denoting “Israel was the army of the Lord and the church is the camp of the saints” (Rev.20:9) under the leadership of Jesus, the Captain of our salvation (Heb.2:10) and the believers are the army of the Lord. (2Tim.3:3-4)

The Camp, the Furniture, was in the shape of the Cross so in turn it was a Cross within a Cross.

The divine placement of the camp of God by Moses represents the placement of the Body of Christ in His own order.

There were 3 tribes on the EAST. (Num.2:3-9) the standard was the LION.

- 1) JUDAH “praise” (Ps.22:3 & 34:1) [74,600 men]
- 2) ZEBULUN “dwelling; habitation ” (Eph.2:19-22) [57,400 men]
- 3) ISSACHAR “reward” (Heb.11:6 & Mt.6:4) [54,400 men]

There were 3 tribes on the WEST. (Num.2:18-24) the standard was the OX.

- 1) EPHRAIM “doubly fruitful; double portion” (Jo.15:16, 2 Kg. 2:9) [40,500]
- 2) MANASSEH “causing forgetfulness” (Jo. 16:21) [32,200 men]
- 3) BENJAMIN “son of my right hand” (Is.59:16) [35,400 men]

There were 3 tribes on the NORTH. (Num.2:25-31) the standard was the EAGLE.

- 1) DAN “he that judges” (1Cor. 2:15) [62,700 men]
- 2) ASHER “happy” (Neh.8:10; Rom.14:17) [41,500 men]
- 3) NAPHTALI “obtain by wrestling”(Gen.32:24-32) [53,400 men]

There were 3 tribes on the SOUTH. (Num. 2:10-16) the standard was the MAN.

- 1) REUBEN “vision of a son” (Gal.4:1-7) [46,500 men]
- 2) SIMEON “he who hear with acceptance” (Is.50:4-6) [59,300 men]
- 3) GAD “a troop” (Jer.12:5, Joel 2:1-11) [45,650 men]

The standard is the 4 beast that are found around the throne of God in the book of Revelation “Rev.4:7”

The placement of the tribe of Levi:

Num.1:47-54 & 3:17-51

As you can see that there are 12 tribes that are in the camp but no ever count the 13th one which is the tribe of LEVI “JOINT TOO.” Ministry (Num.1:47-54 & 3:17-51)

- 1) East side; Moses, Aaron, and the Priests (sons of Aaron)- service
- 2) West side; Gershonites (change of pilgrimage)- 7,500 curtains, covering, & hanging
- 3) North side; Merarites (bitterness) 6,200- boards, bars, pillars, sockets, pins, cords
- 4) South side; Kohathites (congregation) 8,600- cords and the furniture of tabernacle

The camp on the move:

Numbers 10:14-28

As the Shekinah glory or the cloud of God would move the camp to the next place the 3 division of the Levi would break down the tabernacle. It was their responsibilities to move all the pieces of furniture on their shoulder. The responsibilities of those of the house that are in ministry to bear on their shoulders those that have been given to them.

The 1st was Judah

The Gershonites with 2 wagons with the curtains, coverings hangings, excepting the Veil. The Merarites with 4 wagons with the boards, bars, pillars, pins, cords, sockets. This heavier burden could make someone bitter. (Ezek.3:14)

The 2nd was Reuben

The Kohathites would carry the Ark, Table of Shewbread, the Brazen and Golden Altars, and the Laver. Note that move in front of His people in the Cloud and in the midst of His people in the Ark.

The Pillar of Cloud by day and a Pillar of Fire by night meant that the Presence of God was with them. The whole nation was delivered by

The BLOOD of the Passover Lamb (1Jo.5:8)

The WATER baptize into Moses at the Red Sea (Ex.14-15 and 1 Corn.10:2)

The SPIRIT baptize into Moses in the Cloud (Ex. 13)

THE OUTER COURT

THE LAVER & THE BRAZEN ALTAR WERE THE TWO PIECE OF FURNITURE THAT WERE IN THE OUTER COURT

Ex. 27:9-19 & 38:9-20 & Ps.65:4 & 84:10

A cubit equals 18 inches

The Gate was on the East side

The Court was fence in by a wall of FINE TWAIN LINEN hanging of the court hung by Silver Hooks.

The silver hooks were jointed by SILVER CAPS on the top of 60 Pillars that were set in BRASS SOCKETS.

THE Pillars were united by SILVER CONNECTING RODS (fillets).

This Court was SACRED grounds because Jehovah is a Holy God and this was the place that the people would come to bring sacrifice and their offerings for their sins. This was the place where the Priest would make the transfer from the person to the animal the sin that they were bringing the sacrifice for. The Brazen Alter was the place that would burn ALL the sins always. The Cross was the place where our Sins were dealt with.

The Outer Court had two pieces of furniture the Brazen Alter and the Laver.

The Laver speaks of the Baptism of Water. For we are wash by the water of the Word, It also speaks of the way that we need to walk clean before the Lord. This was the place that All Israel got come to daily for the forgiveness of sin. "WHAT CAN WASH AWAY MY SIN NOTHING BUTN THE BLOOD OF JESUS."

There are many type of description for the Outer Court. It was for all Israel, The Law Age,

THE DIMENSIONS:

EX.27:9-19

The perimeter of the court was 100 cubits to the north x 100 cubits to the south x 50 cubits to the east x 50 cubits to the west = 300 cubits that is a type of complete deliverance x 5 cubits high (the fine twain linen) = 1500 cubit or 1500 years it speaks of the Law Age that was from Moses to Jesus.

Noah Ark was 300 ft long x 50 cubits wide x 30 cubits height, and like the tabernacle it only had one (1) way in through the door. Jesus said that He is the door to the Father. The way in to the tabernacle was the Gate on the East.

THE CURTAINS:

EX. 27: 9-19 & 38:9-20

The linen curtains were made from fine twined linen. They were held up by the Pillars the Curtains were 5 cubits high and 50 cubits wide and they were White.

White stands for the righteousness of the saints. (Rev.19:8) and they hang on the ATONEMENT (silver) of Christ and it's to be display to the world, (Rom.14:17)

The Believers are the Silver Hooks which uphold God's standard of Righteousness in the earth. Shows that there is a wall of God's Presence around His people (Zech.2:5 & PS.125:1-2). This barrier of Demarcation shuts out the sinner and shuts in the saints (Num.3:10)

THE PILLARS:

Ex.27:9-19

60 Pillars there were 10 to the East, 10 on the West, 20 on the North, and 20 on the South. They speak of the 60 RIGHTEOUS men that are Joseph side from Adam to Christ. (Mat.1:1-16 & Lk.3:23-38) they speak of the OVERCOMERS in the church. (Jer.1:18 & Gal.2:9 & Rev.3:12)

They had a Silver Cap that represents the CROWN. God's people are Crown with the glory of redemption's plan and also wear the Helmet of Salvation (Eph.6:17)

Neh.9:12 represent STRENGTH not easily move by the desert storms.

This Pillars were 5 cubits high made of SHITTIM WOOD. "INCORRUPTIBLE WOOD" speaks of the SINLESS HUMANITY of Jesus. (Heb.2:14 & 4:15 & 1Jo.4:1-3) they were overlay with Brass which speaks of Judgment, Strength, Durability, Stability, and the ministry of the Holy Ghost teaches that Sin must be judged.

The Brass Sockets can represent FEET. (Rev.1:15; 2:18) the FEET company of the body of Christ will minister judgment. Also speaks lowest place humility.

THE PINS:

Ex. 38:20 & (Zech.10:1-7 & Is.22:20-25)

They were like tent stakes and the word could be translated as A Nail.

They were made of Brass and they held all the cords to the ground.

They speak of the nails of Judgment that nail Our Savior to the Cross on Golgotha's hill.

They were also called PEGS

THE CORDS:

Num.3:26-27 & (Is.54:2 & Eccl.4:2 & Hos.11:2)

The Cords speak of the support and strength and the Unity and Love.

They speak of the cords of LOVE that holds up the saint's.

The Love that holds us up to the strength of those that is round us.

THE GATE:

Ex.27:16 & 38:18-19

This was the only way into the tabernacle and it was 20 cubits long and 5 cubits high.

This Gate was on the EAST side. On either side was 15 cubits which means REST. The

Gate was held up by 4 Pillars of Brass set in Brass sockets. These Pillars were capped in silver and connected by silver fillets and the Gate hung from silver hooks connected to the Pillars. The Gate was made from needlework from FINE TWAIN LINEN and the colors of BLUE, PURPLE, and AND SCARLET.

LINEN: White pure, clean; speaks of the purity or the righteousness of the saints.

FINE TWAIN: the inner working of the Holy Ghost.

BLUE: this speaks of Heaven and things heavenly in nature.

PURPLE: speaks of ROYALTY and KINGSHIP.

SCARLET: this color is for the blood and speaks of the sacrifice or the humanity of the suffering of the Lord.

The Pillars stand for the 4 Gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

It also speaks of the Way of the Lord. (Jo.14:6.)

THE BRAZEN ALTER UTENSILS:

Lev.6:10-11 & Num.19:17

- A) PANS are for removing the ASHES which speaks of when Christ the Head said IT IS FINISH. The ashes were removed to a clean place.
- B) SHOVELS used for feeding the FIRE, collecting the ashes, for placing the coals into the Censers for the GOLDEN ALTAR
- C) BASIN bowls which were used to Contain the BLOOD which was pour out at the base of the Altar or SPRINKLED. This speaks of the unselfish, voluntary emptying of the Christ the head and body.
- D) FLESHHOOKS used for arranging and placing the pieces of the animal's body until it was completely consumed.
- E) FIREPANS these are the actually CENSERS used to carry coals from the Brazen Altar to the Golden Altar.

The CONTINUAL FIRE was lit by God but it was the responsibility of the Priest to keep the Fire going. (Lev.6:12-13) It showed the PURIFY, REVEAL, AND TRANSFIGURE the body of Christ.

THE CARRIERS:

Num. 4:1-33 it was the Levities that would be the burden bears.

The KOHATHITES would carry the furniture of the Tabernacle. (Num.4:1-20)

The GERSHONITES would carry the curtains, the covering, hanging of the court, gate, cords, and the entire instrument for the service, (Num.4:21-28) but not the Veil.

The MERARITES would carry the boards, bars, pillars, pins, sockets, and cords. (Num.4:29-33)

The Boards of the tent:

Ex.26:15-30; 30:11-16; 36:20-34; 38:25-27 (see page 37)

This is for the Priesthood of the believers the many member body of Christ.

Acted as the frame works of the tabernacle

There were a total of 48 boards, 20 on the North and South, 6 on the West, and 2 corners

Each board was 10 cubit high x 1 ½ cubit wide and 4 inches thick

They were made of Shittim wood and overlay with Gold

They rest on 2 silver sockets and they were secured by tenons for each board

They were held by 5 Bar on each side that went into golden rings (see page 38)

THE HOLY PLACE

This represents the present church age.

The Door to the Holy Place is the Holy Ghost Baptism. (Acts 2).

This is the place that only the priest and the High Priest could go into.

In this part the glory of God was mix with Man.

The three piece of furniture are the Candlestick, Altar of Incense, and the Table of Shewbread. The two pieces of furniture that was made of Shittim Wood overlay with Gold.

These two pieces of furniture are the table of Shewbread and the Alter of Incense.

The light of this place was the Candlestick.

This was the place that had daily sacrifice and the Priest would come in and light the wicks for the Candlestick two times a day.

THE TENT:

Ex. 26:1-15

The Curtains of the tent was of Fine twain linen, of blue, purple, and scarlet, and the length of 28 cubits and the breadth of 4 cubits. It had 4 covering of the tent was of Badger Skin, Ram Skin, Goats Hair, and Fine Linen.

THE DIMENSION:

Ex. 26:16-30

20 X 10X 10 = 2000

It speaks of the church age.

“SEE CHART” see page 21 & 50

THE DOOR:

Ex.26:36-37 & 36:37-38

Another name was the hanging. It was made of fine twain linen with blue, purple, and scarlet, and its needle works.

It was hung on 5 Pillars. It was 10 cubits high x 10 cubits wide.

Other name that it was called by is the hanging for the door of the tent.

It speaks of the door Himself the Lord Jesus Christ.

The 5 Pillars speaks of the Five Fold Ministry which are The Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, and Teacher.

It also speaks of the truth of the Lord. (Jo.14:6)

This Door hung on 5 Pillars

THE PILLARS:

Ex.26:37

It had 5 Pillars they were made of SHITTIM WOOD and overlay with GOLD.

These 5 Pillars stand for the 5 fold ministry which is the Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, and Teachers. We are being made the Priest and Kings in the Kingdom of God.

The Wood is for the nature of man.

The Gold is for the Divinity.

They had the sockets of brass.

They had the hooks, chapiters, and their fillets of gold.

The Pillars were 10 cubits high, and had crowns of silver.

THE TABLE OF SHEWBREAD UTENSILS:

Ex.25:23-30

This had the DISHES, SPOONS, BOWLS, and COVERS.

DISHES: for the placement of the Bread, Setting the Bread in order.

SPOON: for feeding the Priest and 12 spoon speaks of Divine Order and Government.

BOWLS AND COVERS: for drinking the Wine. This speaks of Communion of the Lord.

The 12 loafs of Bread was replaced every 6 days. It was made of Fine Flour and Pure Frankincense. Jesus said that He is the Bread of Life. (Jo.6:35)

There was 12 Loaf one for each tribe, 12 Loaf for the Apostles and for the 12 Door of heaven.

John 12:24 the cycle of the wheat “fell, die, grow, cut, shifted, beat, mix, bake, and eat.

This speaks of Food for the Priest, communion for the church, and healing for ALL.

When we eat from this table we receive the pure word of God for our soul.

John 17:21 Jesus prayed that we be One like He and the Father.

1Corn.10:17 we are One Bread and One Body.

THE ALTAR OF INCENSE UTENSILS:

Ex. 30:9

This only had the Censer which was used to carry the ashes from the brazen altar to the altar of incense on the Day of Atonement by the High Priest.

There was incense that was burned day for the Prayers, Praise, and Worship.

The Incense was made up of STACTE, ONYCHA, GALBANUM, FRANKINCENSE, and SALT.

THE MOST HOLY PLACE

THE ARK and the MERCY SEAT are the two pieces of furniture found in this place. This is the place that the HIGH PRIEST would come once a year to make Atonement for the whole camp.

This represents the coming Kingdom Age

The four square and cube structure speaks of the City of God.

THE DIMENSION:

10 x 10 x 10 = 1000 years of Kingdom Age.

THE VEIL:

Ex. 26:33-37 & 36:35-36 & Heb.9:2-5

It is called the Vail of the Covering or the Testimony. The Hebrew word means a screen, separator, curtain, and that which hides. It was the only entrance to the Most Holy Place. The Vail was made of “cunning work”, and the cherubim’s.

The High Priest would go in once a year on the Day of Atonement in the 7th month.

This Veil was 10 cubits x 10 cubits x 4 inches thick.

The Vail speaks of the truth of the Lord.

This Vail hung on 4 Pillars

The PILLARS:

Ex.26:32

There are 4 pillars made of wood and overlay with gold.

These pillars were set in 4 silver sockets and were cut off and uncrowned.

The Vail hung from gold hooks connected to the pillars.

The pillars represent set forward the earthly ministry of the Word made flesh.

THE COVERING:

Ex.26:1-15 see page 43

These curtains were made of Fine Twain Linen. This section of the tabernacle was cover by the same covering of the Holy Place.

THE LEVITICAL PRIESTHOOD:

Ex.28:1 & Num. 3:1-13

This was the tribe that did not receive land. When Joshua give out the land but they got CITIES.

This speaks of the ministry of Jesus on the earth as our Priest. Jesus is NOT looking for land here on this earth He is looking for those that are of His City.

Thus this is the 13th Tribe of Israel. Jesus and His 12 Disciple = 13

THE HIGH PRIEST AND HIS GARMENT:

See page 91-104 of book 2

This was for Aaron.

Ex.28:1-43 & 39:1-5

This High Priest was the only one that could go behind the Veil only one day out of year and this was on the of Atonement.

This Garment was to represent the Christ and His church.

THE PRIEST AND THEIR GARMENTS:

Nadab and Abihu and Eleazar and Ithamar.

These are the Sons of Aaron the High Priest that minister before the Lord in house by their father.

THE LEVI AND THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES:

These are the one that would do the rest of the work around the tabernacle. It was their duties to put up and take the tent and all of parts as they had been told by Moses. It was their duty to keep up the house of the Lord.

THEIR POSITION AND SYMBOLS:

On the East Moses and Aaron the Lion

On the West Gershonites the Ox or Calf

On the North Merarites the fling Eagle

On the South Kohathites the Man
