12. What is meant by the statement, “And they overcame by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony?”
13. What keeps us from seeing the “glorified Christ?” Explain.
14. What does the Bible say about a “seven-year Tribulation? Explain.
15. What is the Millennium? What is an argument for it not being literal? When does it take place? What is associated with the “millennium?” Explain.
16. There are several explanations of the “two witnesses.” In what way has the teaching of this course presented these two witnesses? How does that affect us?
17. What do you believe the Bible means spiritually about a “new heaven” and a “new earth?”
18. John said the Holy City was the Lamb's Bride. The bride is the Body of Christ. Explain how the Holy City, the New Jerusalem corresponds the Body of Christ. Give some specific examples.
19. In Daniel 9:24-27 there are six things which transpire as the result of the 70 weeks of Daniel. What are these six accomplishments? How were they fulfilled? What do the 70 weeks represent? When was the 69th week fulfilled? The 70th week?
20. What do dispensationalists say that Daniel's Seventieth Week refer to? When do they say this takes place? What is the flaw in this thinking? When will it actually be fulfilled?
