Isaiah and Ezekiel

There is no text book for this course. The course consists of two difference classes: Isaiah and Ezekiel. There is a study guide for Isaiah, but not for Ezekiel. It is important that you take good notes. The graduate paper could be on Isaiah and Ezekiel's role in the restoration of Israel from Babylonian Captivity. Or you could simply write a paper on anyway these two prophets were interrelated. The final topic is left up to you.

Your grade will be based on:

1. Reading assignments.
2. Written assignment.
3. Attendance and class participation (view all videos).
4. A graduate-level paper on any topic covered in this course
5. Final Exam.

Guidelines for Paper:

1. The paper should be 8 to 10 pages, double spaced.
2. The paper should be written in a scholarly manner, using the APA Manual as a guideline for writing.
3. The paper should be researched with a minimum of 6 references.

If you do not own a copy of Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, edition 6, you need to obtain one. You will need this manual for any paper submitted in any course of the graduate program, including the master's thesis and doctoral dissertation.
