1. Make a distinction between the “world” and the “earth.”
2. What is God's general purpose for the earth?
3. Name three major purposes of God discussed in the text.
4. What was God's original mandate for man and the earth?
5. What was the ensuing mandate of God after man's fall?
6. Describe briefly what is meant by “the seed of Abraham” as it pertains to the Kingdom of God.
7. Why does Satan put such a premium on death?
8. Describe the traditional dispensationalist view of the rapture?
9. Why do you think Satan would want to perpetrate the lie of an “any-moment-fly-away-removal-of-the-saints-from-the-earth-rapture?”
10. In actuality, what three major events take place at the coming of the Lord according to Paul's writings?
11. What are three major timings of the rapture as compared to the Millennium.
12. Give three examples from the Word of God which could serve as a justification for God's sustaining and protecting power for His people in days of great darkness, evil, or tribulation.
13. What does God expect of His people when days of darkness shall cover the earth and gross darkness the people?
14. What essentially has been the differentiation in this course between the concept of the “present-day kingdom” and the “eternal kingdom?” Briefly describe each.
15. We have associated the “millennium” with a 1000-year period of time. This oftentimes has been the designation of the “kingdom.” Regardless of your viewpoint of a literal or spiritual time, what is the significance of this period?
16. What are some of the conditions of this “kingdom” period?
17. What is the significance of scriptural references to the “third day” or third wave of the Holy Spirit?
18. Give two scriptural references to the mention of the “third day.”
19. Summarize God's purposes in the earth as they compare to heaven. Or, explain, “Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, in earth as it is in heaven.”
20. What does the “coming of Jesus” mean to you?
