The course is based on the book, *The Century of the Holy Spirit: 100 Years of Pentecostal and Charismatic Renewal*, by Vinson Synan.

This is a history course in which you really need to get the book and read it. You will get much more out of the course, and it will give you a greater appreciation of the roots of the modern-day Pentecostal/Charismatic movement.

I would recommend that you answer questions after each lesson that pertain to that lesson. It would be better for you to have the presentation of the lessons before attempting to answer the questions.

The questions are to be answered on separate paper. The paper should include the questions AND answers. The paper must be typed. If it is not, there will have to be a substantial deduction of points.

You must have good attendance in the classes (no more than one “unexcused” absence. If you have to miss for any other reason than the one time, you will have to notify me before class in order for you to have the opportunity to make the class up.
