Ambassadors of Prayer & Strategists of Intercession

Ambassador = a diplomat of the highest rank often representing a king; accredited as representative in residence by one government to another.	Notes:
Prayer = a humble expression addressed to God for communion, thanksgiving, revelation and petition.	
Strategist = one who is responsible for the overall planning and conduct of large-scale military applications. Expert designer of strategies, schemes, tactics and maneuvers obtained in intercession for the purposes of staging surprise attacks upon the kingdom of darkness and all its representative forces.	
Intercession = means "to strike upon," or "against", "to come between" for another; prayer on behalf of another which naturally arises from an instinct of the heart, not really prompted by affection and interest but recognizing that God's interest is not merely individual, but social.	
I. Principles of Intercession for Ambassadors & Stratagists	
Col 1:26-27 "The mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."	
1) God is eternal Spirit and understanding of/for the times and seasons in which we live upon the earth comes from Him.	
 a) The field of our warfare is the realm of the spirit (Eph. 6:12-18). b) All realms seen and unseen are under the dominion of God (Psalms 103:19-22). c). Revelation-Manifestation is our prayer dominion on earth 	
(Rev.1:1-2)	Ministry of Prayer

- 2) Christ being manifested in us through governmentalprayer is the means by which God intends to overthrow the kingdom of darkness on earth to establish His own dwelling.
 - a) The manifestation of Christ is the destruction of the works of the devil (**Rev.12: 7-12; I John 3:8**).
 - b) "Christ in You" is the execution of the judgement-power of God subduing His enemies (11Cor. 10:4-6; Eph. 3:9-11)
 - c) The establishment of the Kingdom of God in heaven is the advancement of the Kingdom of God on earth (Mt.11:12-15).
