 - a. Occurs over 400 times in OT
 - b. Emphasizes ecstatic nature of prophetic word
 - 2. Nataf to drop, to fall as drops of rain
 - a. Emphasis on divine origin of prophecy
- D. Propheteuo (Greek) NT word means "to say or speak forth or fore"
 - 1. Forthtelling speaking for message
- 2. Foretelling declaring beforehand something that will surely come to pass

V. THREE SPIRITS INVOLVED IN PROPHECY

- A. Human Spirit
 - 1. Jer. 23:16 "...they speak a vision of their own heart and not out of the mouth of the Lord."
 - 2. Verse 17 "...walketh after the imagination of his own heart..."
 - 3. Verse 26 "Yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart"
 - 4. Ezek. 13:2 "Prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy, and say thou unto them that prophesy out of their own hearts..."
 - 5. Ezek. 13:17 "...set thy face against the daughters of thy people which prophesy out of their own heart..."
- B. Satanic Spirit
 - 1. Saved and deluded
 - 2. Unsaved, controlled and used of evil spirits
 - 3. I Tim. 4:1-2 "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing

spirits, and doctrines of devil. Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron."
