1 EVERY GOOD AND PERFECT GIFT COMES FROM ABOVE

- 1.1 James 1:17 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."
- 1.2 If earthly father knows how to give good gifts...how much more will our heavenly father give us the <u>gift of the Holy Ghost...</u>
- 1.3 Eph. 4:7 "But unto everyone of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ."

2 TWO BASIC GREEK WORDS FOR GIFT

- 2.1 <u>Dorea</u> denotes "a free gift," stressing its gratuitous character; it is always used in the NT of a spiritual or supernatural gift
- 2.1.1 John 4:10 "Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water."
- 2.1.2 Acts 8:20 "But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money."
 - 2.1.3 Rom 5:15 "But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace
- of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many."
 - 2.2 Charisma "A gift of grace, a gift involving grace."
