I. INSPIRATIONAL GIFTS

- A. Prophecy
 - 1. Supernatural utterance in a known tongue
- B. Divers kinds of tongues a supernatural utterance in unknown tongue

C. Interpretation of tongues - supernatural showing forth by the Spirit the meaning of an utterance in other tongues

II. PROPHECY

A. To flow forth; to speak for another; speaking forth the mind and counsel of God

B. Not preaching

- C. Should not be confused with office of prophet
 - 1. Simple gift has no revelation
 - 2. Should not confuse forthtelling with foretelling
 - 3. Purpose of prophecy
 - a. Edification to build up
 - b. Exhortation to encourage to continue on; calling nearer to God
 - c. Comfort
 - 4. Different levels of authority
 - a. Gift
 - b. Office
 - c. Presbytery
 - 5. Gift of prophecy not directive, but confirmation
- D. Rules for edification
 - 1. Does it edify?
 - 2. How will it effect the church?
 - 3. How can the gift operate for the greatest benefit of the body?
- E. Orderly
 - 1. Manner in which done
 - a. Not abusive, exhibitionist, emotionally extravagant
 - b. Not screaming, jerking, flowing with negativism
 - 2. Timing
 - a. Spirit of prophet subject to prophet
 - b. Preferring one another
 - c. Two or three not monopolizing
 - d. Best time after strong worship
 - 3. Unity of message or theme
- F. To be judged
 - 1. Why judged?
 - a. Know in part, prophesy in part
 - (1) Still mixture

(2) Spirit, man, devil

b. Despise not prophesyings, prove all things, hold fast that which is good

- c. Let the prophets speak two or three, let others judge
- d. Try the spirits, whether they are of God
- 2. Who is to judge?
 - a. Believers
 - b. Elders
 - c. Gift of discernment
 - d. Prophets
- 3. How to judge?
 - a. By the word
 - b. Fruit borne
 - c. Witness of spirit

III. DIVERS KINDS OF TONGUES

A. Differentiation of tongues

- 1. Initial evidence of Holy Spirit
- 2. Prayer language
 - a. Pray to God
 - b. Edify self
- 3. Supernatural utterance in assembly (to be interpreted)
- B. Do all speak with tongues? (gift of tongues)
- C. Place of tongues in assembly
 - 1. Sign to unbeliever
 - a. Evidence of supernatural
 - b. Witness of hearing foreign language
 - 2. Equivalent to prophecy
 - 3. Lift congregation into praise or prayer

IV. INTERPRETATION OF TONGUES

A. Supernatural showing forth by the Spirit the meaning of an utterance in other tongues

- B. Not a translation
- C. Reason for longer or shorter interpretation
 - 1. Confusion of tongues and praise
 - 2. Extends into prophecy
- D. Speaker should seek to interpret

V. PRACTICAL POINTS OF WISDOM TO GOVERN PROPHESYING IN THE ASSEMBLY

A. Refrain from scolding, lecturing, or whipping people through prophecy-also applies to extremely negative, harsh or judgmental prophesying

- B. Avoid prophesying pet doctrines and favorite emphases
- C. Avoid correcting the leadership through prophecy

D. Avoid introducing brand new direction into the service through prophecy

E. Stay in tune with the meeting. Do not go cross-current

F. Refrain from yelling, screaming, whining or other extremes in voice or manner

G. Refrain from injecting self and personal problems into your prophecy: moods, pressures or circumstances, anger, irritation, opinions

H. Stick to the word (especially as beginners)
