- A. Freely you have received, freely give
- B. II Cor. 9:7 "Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him

give; not grudgingly, or of necessity; for God loveth a cheerful giver."

VII. HOW MUCH ARE WE TO GIVE?

A. The tithe is holy--belongs to the Lord; for the business of God

- B. Offerings
 - 1. Freewill offerings to build the house of the Lord
 - 2. Offerings for the storehouse of the Lord
- C. Alms giving

1. Eph. 4:28 - "Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth."

2. Luke 11:41 - "Give alms of such as ye have."

D. Ministering to the saints

 I Co. 16:1-2 - "Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.
Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as <u>God hath prospered him</u>, that there be no gatherings when I come."

2. "As touching the ministering to the saints, it is superfluous for me to write to you: For I know the forwardness of your mind, for

which I boast of you. To I know the forwardness of your mina, for which I boast of you to them of Macedonia, that Achaia was ready a year ago; and your zeal hath provoked very many. Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in vain in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready: Lest haply if they of Macedonia come with me, and find you unprepared, we (that we say not, ye) should be ashamed in this same confident boasting. Therefore I thought it necessary to exhort the brethren, that they would go before unto you, and make up beforehand your bounty, whereof ye had notice before, that the same might be ready, as a matter of bounty, and not as of covetousness. But this I say, he which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver." (II Co. 9:1-7)

3. II Co. 8:11-15 - "Now therefore perform the doing of it; that as

there was a readiness to will, so there may be a performance also out of that which ye have. For if there be first a willing mind, it is accepted according to that a man hath, and not according to that he hath not. For I mean not that other men be eased, and ye burdened: But by an equality, that now at this time your abundance may be a supply for their want, that their abundance also may be a supply for your want; that there may be equality: As it is written, He that had gathered much had nothing over; and he that had gathered little had no lack."
