"The Anointing of the Holy Spirit"

Ex. 30:25-33

I. THE ANOINTING MAKES THE DIFFERENCE

- A. What is the anointing?
- B. Basic meaning is simply to smear something on an object (usually oil)
- C. Special setting apart for an office or function
- D. Whatever anointing touches becomes holy
- E. Anointing is special unction of Holy Spirit

1. I Jn. 2:27 - "...anointing abides..teaches you of all things."

2. Is. 61:1 - "*The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek...*"

II. THREE OFFICES OR MINISTRIES ANOINTED IN OLD TESTAMENT

- A. Prophet - Elisha anointed to be prophet by Elijah
- B. Priest - "*And thou shalt anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office.*"
- C. King

III. DAVID'S THREEFOLD ANOINTING

- A. Anointed to be king while still a shepherd (general anointing for calling)
- B. Anointed as king of Judah (Anointing that equips and qualifies for service)
- C. Anointed as King of Israel (Anointing for promotion)

IV. MAKE IT AN OIL OF HOLY OINTMENT - EX. 30:25-33

- A. Anointing of vessels
 - 1. Anoint tabernacle, ark of testimony, table and vessels, candlestick and vessels, altar of incense
 - 2. Altar of burnt offering, laver and his foot
 - 3. Thou shalt sanctify them, that they may be most holy
 - 4. Whatsoever toucheth them shall be holy
- B. Human vessels anointed - to consecrate them
- C. Upon man's flesh shall it not be poured

- 1. Shall not make any other like it
- 2. Whoever duplicates it or puts upon stranger shall be cut off from his

people

D. Lev. 8:23 - "*Blood applied upon right ear, thumb of right hand, great toe of right foot--then anointing oil applied.*"

V. TOUCH NOT MY ANOINTED AND DO MY PROPHETS NO HARM

A. I Sam. 24:6 - *"The Lord forbid that I should do this unto my master, the Lord's anointed, to stretch forth mine hand against him, seeing he is the anointed of the Lord."*

B. I Sam. 24:10 - *"I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he is the Lord's anointed."*

C. II Sam. 1:14 - *"How wast thou not afraid to stretch forth thine hand to destroy the Lord's anointed?"*

D. *"Tell it not in Gath, publish it not in the streets of Askelon; lest the daughters of the uncircumcised triumph."* - II Sam. 1:20

VI. I SHALL BE ANOINTED WITH FRESH OIL - PS. 92:10

A. Heb. 1:9 - *"..therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows."*

B. Ps. 23:5 - *"Thou anointedst my head with oil."*

VII. AND THE YOKE SHALL BE DESTROYED BECAUSE OF THE ANOINTING - IS. 10:27

VIII. ANOINTING FOR HEALING - James 5:14 - *Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him."*

IX. THE ANOINTING ABIDES - I John 2:27 - *"But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him."*
