#### I. THE REIGN OF SPIRITUAL DEATH

- A. Separation from God
  - 1. Man ceases to walk in realm of Spirit
  - 2. Birth of reason
  - 3. Man's ability severed from God's ability
- B. Redemption more than forgiveness
  - 1. Giving of new nature
  - 2. Power over dominion of sin
- C. Man must be freed from nature of Satan before receive nature of God

#### II. MAN'S NEED FOR ETERNAL LIFE

- A. Only solution to man's needs
- B. Make possible to receive spirit of God
- C. Allow fellowship with the Father
- D. Able to walk in faith realm--live by the word of God

#### III. WHY JESUS HAD TO DIE

- A. To make us the righteousness of God to partake of divine nature of God
- B. Why did God not just wipe Satan out?
- C. Why did God not just declare us righteous?
- D. Why did Jesus' obedience bring us justification

### IV. GOD IS A JUST GOD

- A. He deals in righteousness
- B. Must see that penalty is paid
  - 1. Someone has to pay penalty
  - 2. Those who reject must be dealt penalty of sin
- C. To set us free from Satan must be on legal grounds
  - 1. Satan had legal right to earth
    - a. Adam gave him that right
    - b. "...for it hath been delivered unto me, and to whomsoever I will I give it."
- 2. Cannot go against his own nature of righteousness--will deal justly even with Satan
  - a. Cannot take advantage of Satan
  - b. II Co. 4:2
    - (1) Have renounced hidden things of dishonesty
    - (2) Not walking in craftiness
    - (3) Not handling word of God deceitfully
  - c. End does not justify means

# D. God is stronger than the devil

## V. LEGALLY, MAN MUST REDEEM MAN

- A. Redeem by paying the penalty of death
- B. Need for God-man
- C. God's son the only one who could pay penalty
  - 1. When penalty paid, he was declared righteous
  - 2. We are righteous because we have been identified with him
  - 3. If this identification is not legal, neither is the identification with Adam legal which made us subject to the bondage of Satan
- D. We are identified by faith
  - 1. Crucified with him
  - 2. Risen with him
  - 3. Partakers of his divine nature
  - 4. Partakers of healing
