#### I. WHO REDEEMETH THY LIFE FROM DESTRUCTION

- A. Destruction
  - 1. Decay, ruin, corruption
  - 2. A pit (espec. a trap); prison
- B. Destruction shall be to workers of iniquity
- C. No wasting nor destruction in thy borders Is. 60:18
  - 1. A thousand shall fall at thy side, ten thousand at thy right hand...
  - 2. Ex. 12:23 "...when see blood...will not suffer destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you."
- D. Job 5:19-22
- 1. Deliver thee in six troubles; yea, in seven there shall no evil touch thee
- 2. In famine redeem from death; in war from the power of the sword
  - 3. Hid from the scourge of the tongue
  - 4. Not be afraid of destruction when it cometh
  - 5. At destruction and famine thou shalt laugh
