Hebrew Words for Praise

Worship is giving to God the glory that is due His name (Ps. 29:2) - "Give unto the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness."

# I. HALAL (1984)

- A. To be clamorously foolish; to rave; to magnify.
- B. Strong's 01984 To be boastful; to make a fool of oneself; to act madly; act like a madman.

From 2342 (chuwl) - to twist, whirl, dance.

Ps. 149:3

Jer. 31:13 - "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the <u>dance</u>, both young old together: for I will turn their mourning into joy, and will comfort them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow."

- 2. <u>chagag</u> (khaw-gag') celebration, dance.
- 3. <u>karar</u> (kaw-rar')- to whirl, dance. David danced before the Lord with all his might.
- 4. <u>choros</u> (khor-os') NT (5525) a band (of dancers and singers), circular dance, a dance, dancing. (Prodigal son returning home).

### B. CLAPPING THE HANDS

- 1. Ps. 47:1 "O clap your hands all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph."
- 2. Ps. 98:8 "Let the floods clap their hands; let the hills be joyful together."
- 3. Is. 55:12 "For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands."
