- 3. THE COMING AGE OF PEACE.
  - 1. All wars and strivings will be over.
  - 2. Spears beaten into plowshares.
  - 3. Universal peace will prevail.

- 4. THE WILL OF GOD IS THE FRUIT OF PEACE.
  - 1. "For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness,

- and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost." (Ro. 14:17).
- 2. "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, <u>peace</u>, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith..." (Ga. 5:22).
- 3. "Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and <u>peace</u> in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost." (Ro. 15:13).
- 4. "And the fruit of righteousness is sown in <u>peace</u> of them that make <u>peace</u>." (Jas. 3:18).
- 5. "And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever." (Is. 26:3).
- 6. "And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye ae called in one body; and be ye thankful." (Col. 3:15)

## 5. BUT THERE ARE CONTENTIONS AND STRIFES.

- 1. Contentions among you "For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you." (I Co. 1:11).
- Don't allow contention to continue "Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease." (Pr. 22:10).
- 3. A contentious person adds fuel to fire "As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a contentious man to kindle strife." (Pr. 26:21).
- Contentious mates -
  - 1. "It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman." (Pr. 21:19).
  - 2. "A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike." (Pr. 27:15).

### 6. WE ARE COMMANDED TO LIVE IN PEACE.
