1. PROPHECY GOD'S MEANS OF COMMUNICATION.

- 1. Properts and prophecies always been heaven's main channels for broadcasting the thoughts of God to mankind.
- 2. Open heavens--release of propehtic flow.
- 3. Prophecy brings illumination, revelation, and life.
- 4. Designed to prepare way and people for coming fo the Lord.

3. DIFFERENT PROPHETIC REALMS.

- 1. Unconditional/general prophecies.
 - 1. Logos scriptures which reveal the nature, character, and purposes of God.
 - 2. Decress which will come to pass at some time, and place with some people.
- 2. Conditional/personal prophecies.
 - 1. Prophecies God has spoken to people in the Bible and even in our present day.
 - 2. Prophetic rhema words which can fail because of man's improper response.

5. LOGOS VS. RHEMA.

- 1. Logos. Complete, infallible, eternal standard of God.
- 2. Rhema. Individual scripture, timely, inspired Word that brings life, power, and faith.

6. CHANNELS OF PROPHECY.

- 1. Office of a prophet.
 - 1. Investment of Christ himself.
 - 2. Has administrative authority; governmental.
 - 3. Flows in area of guidance, instruction, rebuke, judgment, and revelation.
- 2. Prophetic preaching. (If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God).
 - 1. Preaching is speaking Biblical truths which have been researched, studied, arranged for presentation.
 - 2. Prophetic preaching is extemporaneous, inspired; direct voice of God.

- 3. Prophetic Presbytery.
 - 1. Prophetic revelation and confirmation of those called to leadership ministry in the church.
 - 2. Ordination of the five-fold ministry.
 - 3. Confirmation and activation of membership ministries (Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of hands of the presbytery).
 - 4. Prophet reveals call, ordination by presbytery.
- 4. Gift of Prophecy.
 - 1. Body ministry extension; not headship.
 - 2. Edification, exhortation, comfort.
- 5. Spirit of Prophecy; the testimony of Jesus.
 - 1. An anointing arising from Christ within the believer.
 - 2. All may prophesy when spirit of prophecy.
 - 1. When mighty prophetic presence of the Lord eprmeates service.
 - 2. When among a company of prophets.
 - 3. When challenged by minister to let God arise and testify through them by the spirit of prophecy.
- 6. Song of the Lord.
 - 1. Spontaneous, inspired, anointed singing unto the Lord.
 - 2. Any may participate, but mighier when song comes through a prophet, prophetess, or one with gift of prophecy.
 - 3. Spiritual songs same as prophetic song Ateaching and admonishing one another in psalms, and hymns, and spiritual songs.@

 - 1. Determine God's Word on the matter.
 - 1. Must be in agreement with nature and general principles of Word.
 - 2. The will of God.
