1. OFFICE OF PROPHET.

- 3. Praching proclaims logos, prophecy the rhema of the logos.
- 4. Prophetic preaching the oracles of God. 1 Pet. 4;11.

3. PROPHETIC PRESBYTERY.

5. SPIRIT OF PROPHECY.

- 1. Testimony of Jesus.
- 2. Anointing arising from Christ within believer.
- 3. Happens under one of three conditions.
 - 1. Mighty prophetic presence of Lord.

- 2. Come under anointing of comapny of prophets.
- 3. When challenged by minister to let God arise and testify through them by spirit of prophecy.
 - 1. Prophesy according to proportion of faith.
 - 2. For you may all prophesy one by one that all may learn, and all may be comforted.
- 4. Would to God all the Lord's people were prophets (prophesiers).

6. PROPHETIC SONG OF THE LORD.

- 1. Spirit of prophecy expressing thoughts and desires of Christ in song.
- 2. Perhaps the way the Psalms were received.
- 3. Anointing mightier when through prophet or gift of prophecy.
- 4. New song of the Lord.
- 5. Teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs.
