- 2. Rapture means of removing all opposition.
- 3. False "pretrib rapture" diverts attention from God's purpose in the earth.

3. TRADITIONAL RAPTURE TEACHING.

- 1. What is it?
 - 1. Catching away; removal from earth.
 - 1. Term "rapture" not in Bible.
 - 2. Comes from Latin word "rapio" meaning to rape.
 - 3. To seize violently.
 - 2. Traditional visions.
 - 1. Soaring through air.
 - 2. At any moment.
 - 3. Associated with chaos and disaster.
 - 3. Implications.
 - 1. To be with Jesus.
 - 2. Escape world.

- 3. Escape tribulation.
 - (1) Too weak to survive.
 - (2) God is far too good to allow it.
- When is it?
 - 1. Pre-trib born out of fear and selfishness.
 - 2. Mid-trib confusing tribulation and wrath of God.
 - 3. Post-trib go through tribulation, then taken out.

4. HISTORY OF PRE-TRIB RAPTURE.

- 1. Early church did not teach it.
- 2. 1830 Margaret McDonald had a vision.
- 3. Readily received by Edward Irving.
 - 1. Influenced John Darby Plymouth Brethren.
 - 2. Influenced C. I. Scofield.
 - 3. Clarence Larkin charts.

5. REMOVAL FROM EARTH?

- 1. Righteous shall never be removed.
 - 1. Ps. 37:9 "Evil doers shall be cut off; but those that wait upon the Lord, they shall inherit the earth."
 - 2. Ps. 37:11 "Righteous shall inherit the earth and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace."
 - 3. Ps. 37:29 "The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein forever."
 - 4. Pr. 2:21-22 "For the upright shall dwell in the land, and the perfect shall remain in it, but the wicked shall be rooted out."
 - 5. Pr. 10:30 "The righteous shall NEVER BE REMOVED; but the wicked shall NOT INHERIT THE EARTH."
- 2. Wheat and tares (Mt. 13).
 - 1. Tares gathered first.
 - 2. Righteous then shine forth in kingdom of Father.

- 3. As in the days of Noah.
 - 1. Flood came and took them all away.
 - 2. One taken, the other left.
- 4. Father, I pray that you take them not out of the world, but to keep them from the evil.

6. WHAT ACTUALLY TAKES PLACE IF NOT REMOVAL?

- 1. Gathering to the Lord.
 - 1. I Thes. 4:17 "So shall we ever be with the Lord."
 - 2. Eph. 1:10 "...gather together all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth."
 - 3. II Thes. 2:1 "...by the coming of the Lord and our gathering together unto Him."
 - 4. Mt. 24:31 "...shall gather his elect..."
- 2. Resurrection of sainted dead.
 - 1. Two resurrections separated by 1000 years (Rev. 20).
 - 2. Hope of the deceased I Thes. 4.
- 3. Translation of living saints I Cor. 15:51-52--there shall be a change.

7. WHEN SHALL IT BE?

- 1. Mat. 24:29-31 "Immediately after tribulation..."
 - 1. Coming in clouds with power and great glory.
 - 2. Send forth angels with sound of trumpet.
 - 3. Gather his elect.
- 2. Trumpets.
 - 1. I Thes. 4:16 "...with the trump of God..."
 - 2. Mt. 24:31 "...sound of trumpet..."
 - 3. I Cor. 15:51-52 "...at the last trump..."
- 3. The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of the Lord and

- of His Christ (seventh trumpet of Revelation).
- 4. First resurrection after tribulation (Rev. 20:6).
- 5. Man of sin must be revealed <u>first</u> in order to be destroyed with brightness of Lord's coming (II Thes. 2:1-8).

8. HOW SHALL IT BE?

- 1. Behold the bridegroom comes--Go ye out to meet him 10 virgins.
- 2. Caught up together in clouds.
- 3. Meet the Lord in the air.
- 4. So shall we ever be with the Lord.

9. SUMMARY.

- 1. No removal, but:
 - 1. Resurrection and translation.
 - 2. Gathering toegether unto the Lord.
- 2. After tribulation, preceding entrance into kingdom of God.
- 3. Blessed hope of the church.
 - 1. Titus 2:13 "Looking for that blessed hope and glorious appearing of the great God and savior, Jesus Christ."
 - 2. I Jn. 3:3 "And every man who hath this hope in Him, purified himself." (What hope? The hope of being like Him).
- 4. Coming of Christ, not going of the church.
- 5. Appearing of Christ, not disappearing of saints.
