RESURRECTION 95

- 1. THE CRUCIFIXION.
 - 1. Friday was a dark day--literally; the sky turned dark.
 - 2. Satan had triumphed over God=s man once in Adam.
 - 1. Ensuing death marked Satan=s victory.
 - Death passed upon all men--the sentence of death was upon us.
 - 3. Jesus was God=s man.
 - By one man. (Rom 5:17 KJV) For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)
 - By one man. (1 Cor 15:21 KJV) For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. (1 Cor 15:22 KJV) For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
 - 4. When Jesus died, it looked as if Satan had once again triumphed over God=s man.
 - If Jesus had not been raised from the dead, death would still have reigned--but that has been broken!
 - 2. The victory of Jesus was not completed at the cross.
 - 1. It was finished when He rose from the dead.
 - 2. Resurrection signaled His victory over Satan in death.
 - 3. Jesus took the keys of death, hell, and the grave.
- 2. JESUS KNEW HIS DESTINY.

1. He was born to die.

- 1. The lamb prepared from the foundation of the world.
- 2. He became obedient.(Phil 2:8 KJV) And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. (Phil 2:9 KJV) Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: (Phil 2:10 KJV) That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; (Phil 2:11 KJV) And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- 3. Father, let this cup pass from me. (Mat 26:39 KJV) And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

2. On the road to Emmaus.

- (Luke 24:13 KJV) And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs. (Luke 24:14 KJV) And they talked together of all these things which had happened.
- (Luke 24:15 KJV) And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.
- 3. (Luke 24:16 KJV) But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.
- 4. (Luke 24:17 KJV) And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

- 5. (Luke 24:18 KJV) And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?
- 6. (Luke 24:19 KJV) And he said unto them, What things?
 - And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:
 - (Luke 24:20 KJV) And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.
- 7. (Luke 24:21 KJV) But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done.
- 8. (Luke 24:22 KJV) Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre; (Luke 24:23 KJV) And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. (Luke 24:24 KJV) And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.
- 9. (Luke 24:25 KJV) Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:
- 10. (Luke 24:26 KJV) Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? (Luke 24:27 KJV) And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.
- 11. (Luke 24:28 KJV) And they drew nigh unto the village,

whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further. (Luke 24:29 KJV) But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them. (Luke 24:30 KJV) And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them. (Luke 24:31 KJV)

- And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight.
 - 1. (Luke 24:32 KJV) And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?
 - 2. (Luke 24:33 KJV) And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them, (Luke 24:34 KJV) Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon. (Luke 24:35 KJV) And they told what things were done in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking of bread.

3. WHAT TOOK PLACE WHEN JESUS DIED?

- Went to lower parts of the earth to preach to spirits--set captive spirits free.
 - 1. "By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison..." (I Pe. 3:19).
 - 2. Ps. 24:7-10 "Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

 Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even

lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory."

- 2. Spoiled principalities. Col. 2:15 "And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it."
- 4. IT IS TIME TO RECOGNIZE AND TO RECEIVE THE RISEN SAVIOR.
 - 1. He is risen!
 - 2. And He lives forevermore!
 - 3. He has conquered death, hell, and the grave!
 - 4. Because He lives, we can live!
 - 5. "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death." (Rev. 1:18).
