FROM A SERVANT TO A SON

"Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ." (Gal. 4:7)

"Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all." (Ga. 4:1)

1. WE ARE CALLED TO BE A SERVANT.

- 1. Will serve one of two masters.
 - 1. "Nor servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other." (Lu. 16:13).
 - 2. "Art thou called being a servant? Care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use it rather. For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he htat is called, being free, is Christ's servant" (I Co. 7:20-21)
- 2. A Minister is a servant; ministry is serving.
 - 1. The Greek word for <u>minister</u> is diakoneo.
 - 2. Mt. 20:26-28 "But whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister; And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant: Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many."
 - 3. Mt. 23:11 "But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant."
- 3. Obedience.
 - 1. His servant you are to whom you obey.
 - 2. Jesus was obedient.
 - 1. "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered." (Heb. 5:8)
 - 2. Phil. 2:8 "And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross."
- 4. Humility.
 - 1. I Pe. 5:5 "Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble."
 - 2. Exaltation through humility.
 - 1. Ja. 4:10 "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up."
 - 2. Lu. 14:11 "For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted."
 - 3. Humble yourself under the mighty hand of God that he may exalt you

in due season...

- 4. Pr. 15:33 "...before honour is humility..."
- 5. Phil. 2:8-9 "And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name..."
- 5. Faithfulness.
- 6. Disciplined.
 - 1. Discipline is being able to restrain yourslef when the normal tendency is to react or respond.
 - 1. Standing still when the tendency is to move. It takes motivation to move; discipline to stand still.
 - 2. Standing without distraction.
 - (1) Show horses.
 - (2) Coon dogs.
 - 2. Not losing your cool.
- 7. Make disciples of all men.
 - 1. Teach all nations.
 - 1. Teach from the Greek word *matheleus*, meaning to disciple.
 - 2. Means to not only learn, but to become attached to one's teacher and to become his follower in doctrine and conduct of life.
 - 3. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I command youfrom Greek word *didasho*, meaning to instruct by word of mouth.
 - 2. A disciple is a disciplined one.
 - 1. Life in order.
 - 2. Life glorifying to God.
 - 3. Prepared for service through discipline to be useful for God's work.

2. RELATIONSHIP AS A FRIEND.

- 1. Friend (ahab) to have affection for.
 - 1. A bond of love.
 - 2. Close bond that exists between two people whose hearts and minds are blended together as were those of David and Jonathan; a true friend who will love us as his own soul--will stick closer than a brother.
 - 3. Moses was friend of God.
 - 4. Jesus "Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you" (John 15:15).
- 2. No more special relationship than that of a friend.
- 3. One thing to find a friend; another thing to keep that friendship strong and healthy.
 - 1. This takes work.
 - 2. Expect something for nothing; expect other person to do all the giving.
- 4. Mark of a friend.

- 1. Show mercy Pr. 3:3-4
- 2. Show love.
 - 1. Relationship is based on love.
 - 2. Pr. 17:17 "A friend loveth at all times, and a brother is born for adversity."
- 3. Be honest.
- 4. Be trustworthy.
- 5. Be dependable.
- 5. Be considerate.

3. FROM A SERVANT TO A SON.

- 1. We are no longer a servant.
 - 1. "Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ." (Gal. 4:7).
 - 2. The son abides in house forever. "And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever." (Jn. 8:35).
- 2. Mark of a son.
 - 1. Have relationship with Father.
 - 2. Bone of his bone; flesh of His flesh.
- 3. Heir--in line for all that is the Father's.
 - 1. All I have is thine.
 - 2. He that overcomes shall inherit all things.
- 4. God's call to us as sons.
 - 1. "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name." (Jn. 1:12).
 - 2. "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." (Rom. 8:14).
 - 3. "Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not." (I Jn. 3:1).
 - 4. "Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is." (I Jn. 3:2).
