THANKSGIVING

- 1. THANKSGIVING: A FORM OF WORSHIP UNTO THE LORD.
 - 1. Form of praise.
 - 1. (1 Chr 16:8 KJV) Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people.
 - 2. (Heb 13:15 KJV) By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.
 - 2. Entrance into His presence.
 - 1. (Psa 95:2 KJV) Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.
 - 2. (Psa 100:4 KJV) Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
 - 3. *Be anxious for nothing.* (Phil 4:6 NIV) Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

2. WHEN DO WE THANK HIM?

- 1. *Always*. (Eph 5:20 KJV) Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- 2. Forever.
 - 1. (Psa 30:12 KJV) To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.
 - 2. (Psa 79:13 KJV) So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks for ever: we will show forth thy praise to all generations.
- 3. *In everything.* (1 Th 5:18 KJV) In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 4. *For all men.* (1 Tim 2:1 KJV) I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

3. WHERE DO WE THANK HIM?

- 1. *Among the heathen.* (Psa 18:49 KJV) Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.
- 2. *In the congregation.* In the congregation. (Psa 35:18 KJV) I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people.

4. WHY DO WE GIVE THANKS?

- 1. The Lord is good.
 - 1. (1 Chr 16:34 KJV) O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.
 - 2. (Ezra 3:11 KJV) And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD

was laid.

2. He has saved us and delivered us.

- 1. (1 Chr 16:35 KJV) And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, and glory in thy praise.
- 2. (Col 1:12 KJV) Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:
- 3. Unspeakable gift. (2 Cor 9:15 KJV) Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift.

3. *Victory*.

- 1. (1 Cor 15:57 KJV) But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. (2 Cor 2:14 KJV) Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

4. Provisions.

- 1. (Mat 15:36 KJV) And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.
- 2. (Acts 27:34 KJV) Wherefore I pray you to take some meat: for this is for your health: for there shall not an hair fall from the head of any of you.
- 5. *Healing*. (Luke 17:16 KJV) And fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan.
- 6. *Life.* (Psa 6:5 KJV) For in death there is no remembrance of thee: in the grave who shall give thee thanks?

5. NAME AND WONDROUS WORKS.

1. *Thy name is near thy wondrous works.* (Psa 75:1 KJV) To the chief Musician, Altaschith, A Psalm or Song of Asaph. Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, unto thee do we give thanks: for that thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.

- 1. Jehovah-jireh. The Lord our provider.
- 2. Jehovah-rophe. The Lord our healer.
- 3. Jehovah-nissi. The Lord our banner.
- 4. Jehovah-M'kaddesh. Expresses spiritual completeness.
- 5. Jehovah-shalom. The Lord is peace.
- 6. Jehovah-tsidkenu. The Lord our righteousness
- 7. Jehovah-rohi. The Lord our shepherd.
- 8. Jehovah-shammah. The Lord is there.
