## THE DAY OF VISITATION

(Luke 19:44 KJV) And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

### 1. WHAT IS THE DAY OF VISITATION?

- 1. God in the midst of us.
  - 1. Emmanuel God with us.
  - 2. (Zep 3:17 KJV) The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is mighty; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing.
- 2. God speaking to His people.
- 3. God moving in our behalf.
  - 1. Usually manifested by His divine presence and power.
    - 1. His presence brings sense of awe and awesomeness.
    - 2. Sense of His presence brings us to worship.

### 2. AN OUTPOURING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

- 1. (Isa 44:3 KJV) For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:
- 2. Joel "Pour out spirit upon all flesh..."
- 3. Day of Pentecost "This is that which was spoken by prophet Joel..."
- 4. A mighty demonstration of God's power.
- 5. The anointing.

# 3. THE MANIFESTATION OF HIS POWER AND PRESENCE REQUIRES VESSEL OR CHANNEL; AND SUBSTANCE TO FILL OR FLOW THROUGH.

- 1. The vessel.
  - 1. Earthen vessel
    - 1. (2 Cor 4:7 KJV) But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.
    - 2. God is looking for ordinary people who will be extraordinary.
  - 2. New vessel.
    - 1. Don't put new wine in old bottles; don't put new cloth on old garment.
    - 2. Need for "born again" experience.
  - 3. Clean vessels.
    - 1. Jesus rebuked the Pharisees for being clean on outside.
    - 2. Washed by the blood of Jesus.
    - 3. Continual washing by the water of the Word.

- 4. Vessel of honor or consecration set apart.
  - 1. The attraction of the world grows dim.
  - 2. Love not the world; neither the things in the world.
- 5. Yielded vessel; dedicated; submissive.
  - 1. Not our will.
  - 2. God's will.
  - 3. The power of the will.
- 6. Where does desire or motivation come from?
  - 1. Payoff must be greater than cost or sacrifice.
  - 2. Falling in love with Jesus.
  - 3. Our desire is toward Him.
  - 4. Wrong motivation.
    - (1) Praise of men.
    - (2) Promise of attention; limelight; popularity; perception of success.
  - 5. True motivation.
    - (1) Only desire is to serve the Lord.
    - (2) Doesn't matter if ever get attention.
  - 6. True heart of love.
    - (1) heart of humility.
    - (2) Heart of serving; seek what is best for others.
    - (3) A man or woman after God's heart.
  - 7. That which motivates to ministry is love and compassion--because we see people hurting that need help.
- 2. The substance that fills or flows through vessel.
  - 1. The power of the Holy Spirit.
  - 2. The manifestation of the inner Christ.
    - 1. (Col 1:27 KJV) To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:
    - 2. (Gal 2:20 KJV) I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
    - 3. (John 7:38 KJV) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.(John 7:39 KJV) (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
    - 4. (John 9:4 KJV) I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
    - 5. (Acts 5:12 KJV) And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all

with one accord in Solomon's porch.

#### 4. THE POWER OF IMPARTATION.

- 1. What we have we impart to others.
  - 1. (Acts 3:6 KJV) Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.
  - 2. (Mat 10:8 KJV) Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- 2. The power of laying on of hands.
  - 1. (Acts 8:18 KJV) And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,
  - 2. (1 Tim 4:14 KJV) Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.
