2. OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO HONOR HIM.

- 1. **Scripture.** (Psa 96:6 KJV) Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.
- 2. **Definition of honor**.
 - 1. As a noun, honor approximates our ideas of esteem, respect, (high) regard, or (good) reputation.
 - 2. To honor is to recognize the value of someone or thing and to act accordingly.
 - 3. To honor can mean to reward with tangible signs of respect

3. Ways to honor the Lord.

- 1. Recognizing His existence.
 - 1. Believe that He is. (Heb 11:6 KJV) But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
 - 2. (Gen 1:1 KJV) In the beginning God....

3. (John 1:1 KJV) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

4. He is one God.

- 1. (Deu 6:4 KJV) Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:
- 2. (Mark 12:29 KJV) And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:
- 3. He alone is to be worshiped; no split allegiances.

5. He is pre-eminent.

- 1. There is none beside Him; there is none above Him.
- 2. He is the God of heaven and earth (El Elyon).
- 3. He is the King of kings; Lord of lords.
- 4. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and it alone shall prevail.

6. He is the creator of all things.

- 1. (Isa 43:15 KJV) I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.
- 2. All things created by His spoken Word.
 - 1. (Psa 148:5 KJV) Let them praise the name of the LORD: for he commanded, and they were created.
 - 2. (Heb 11:3 KJV) Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

3. OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FEAR HIM.

1. Scriptures.

- 4. Realize He holds all power

1. Scriptures.

- 1. (Psa 18:2 KJV) The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower. (Psa 18:3 KJV) I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

- 1. Commanded to love the Lord.
- 2. If we love Him, we will keep His commandments.
- 3. If love we Him, we will serve Him.
 - 1. <u>His servant you are</u>. (Rom 6:16 KJV) Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?
 - 2. <u>Cannot serve two masters</u>. (Mat 6:24 KJV) No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
- 4. If we love Him, we will seek to please Him.
- 5. If we love Him, we will live for Him.
 - 1. Our lives are committed to Him: we owe our lives to Him.
 - 2. Whether we live or die, we are the Lord=s.
 - 3. We will glorify Him by our lives.
