## THE WHOLE ARMOUR OF GOD

(Eph 6:10 KJV) Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. (Eph 6:11 KJV) Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. (Eph 6:12 KJV) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. (Eph 6:13 KJV) Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. (Eph 6:14 KJV) Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; (Eph 6:15 KJV) And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; (Eph 6:16 KJV) Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. (Eph 6:17 KJV) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: (Eph 6:18 KJV) Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

- 1. BE STRONG IN THE LORD AND THE POWER OF HIS MIGHT.
- 2. PUT ON THE WHOLE ARMOUR OF GOD.
- 3. OTHER PIECES OF ARMOUR.
  - 1. The Word of God.
    - 1. Essential to know the Word (Jn. 8:32-34)
    - 2. To exercise legal rights, must know God=s Word.
    - 3. Satan=s power to deceive based on ground of ignorance. The Word enlightens our ignorance.
    - 4. Jesus used it is written to overcome Satan. (Mat 4:1-10; psa 119:130; eph 1:15-22; 1 Joh 2:12-14; Rev 12:11; 2 Cor 2:11; Eph. 6:17).
  - 2. The name of Jesus.
    - 1. Jesus gave us the legal right to use His name.
    - 2. His name represents our power and authority.
    - 3. He stands behind His name.
    - 4. There is no higher authority.
    - 5. The power is not in us, but in Him whose name we bear. Mat 10:1,8; Luk 9:1; Mark 3:15; 6:7, 13; 16:17; Acts 16:18; Phil 2:9-11; Joh 16:23-24; 14:13-15; Lu 10:17-20.
  - 3. Christ in you.
    - 1. By new birth, Holy Spirit indwells believer.
    - 2. Greater is He (1 Jo 2:14; Gal 4:6; Col 1:27; Eph 1:17-23; Joh 1:12; 1 Joh 4:17; 1 Cor 6:17).
  - 4. The blood of Jesus.
    - 1. The sinless and incorruptible blood of Jesus is the cleansing power in the believer against sin (1 Joh 1:5-6).
    - 2. The blood of Christ is our redemption ground. It is our justification and it

- keeps us clean before God (Rom. 3:25; Rev 12:11).
- 3. The power of the Holy Spirit. (Mat 12:28; Acts 1:5,8; Luk 24:49)
- 4. The gifts of the Spirit.
- 5. The whole armour of God (Eph. 6:10-18; Rom 13:12; 2 Cor 6:7; Rom 10:6-17)
