1. FOR THIS CAUSE MANY ARE WEAK AND SICKLY - I Cor. 11:30
 1. Need for faith and healing
 2. Faith replacing fear

2. NOT DISCERNING THE LORD'S BODY
 1. Take eat, this is my body, which is broken for you
 2. As oft...do show the Lord's death...

3. HAS BORNE OUR GRIEFS, CARRIED OUR SORROWS
 1. Grievs - sickness
 2. Sorrows - pain
 3. Mat. 8:17 - Himself took our infirmities and bare our sicknesses
 4. Is. 53:11 - "...for he shall bear their iniquities..."
 5. Is. 53:12 - "...and he bare the sin of many..."

4. WOUNDED FOR OUR TRANSGRESSIONS

5. BRUISED FOR OUR INIQUITIES
 1. Bruise is inward wound
 2. Jesus suffered for our inward hurts

6. BY HIS STRIPES WE ARE HEALED

7. JESUS BECAME OUR SUBSTITUTE
 1. As the serpent was lifted up
 1. Serpent became the curse (serpent who destroyed)
 2. Jesus became a curse, to redeem us from the curse
 1. Gal. 3:13 - "*Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us; for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.*"
 2. II Cor. 5:21 - "*For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.*"
 3. II Cor. 8:9 - "*For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.*"
