1. ESTABLISHING WHO THE CHOSEN OF THE LORD IS.
2. PURPOSES OF GOD TO BE FULFILLED THROUGH THE CHURCH, OR THE BODY OF CHRIST.
3. THE BODY OF CHRIST AS AN EXTENSION OF THE HEAD.
 1. Jesus Christ is the head. Eph. 1:22-23.
 2. Body is the fulness of him that filleth all in all.
 3. 1 Cor. 12:12. AAs the body has many members, so is Christ. @
 4. He is the vine; we are the branches.
 5. He is the source of life; we produce the fruit.
 6. Put all things under his feet.
 7. We are the feet of the Body of Christ.
4. RELATIONSHIP OF THE HEAD TO THE BODY.
 1. Head controls body; body carries out commands.
 2. What Jesus did legally, we are to walk out.
 1. Purposes of God.
 2. Works of God.
 3. Conquer every enemy; subdue the earth.
 4. Bring restoration.
 3. Head birthed first, then feet.
 4. Place of feet to be made glorious.
 1. Is 60:13. AAnd I will make the place of my feet glorious. @
 2. Where is the place of his feet?
 3. Heaven is my throne, earth is my footstool.
 4. The earth is to be made glorious.
 5. The earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord.
 5. Government upon his shoulders. Who are the shoulders?
 6. We are the hands of God; the extension of God in the earth.
 1. These things shall you do, and greater things.
 2. Not greater in quality, but in quantity.
 3. Jesus was limited in time and space, and the fact he was only one.
 4. The anointing is limitless, and sheer numbers makes for greater works.
 5. The spirit of the Lord is upon me.
 1. Preach good tidings to the meek.
 2. Bind up brokenhearted.
 3. Proclaim liberty to the captives.
 4. Opening of the prison to them that are bound.
 5. They shall build the old wastes, repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.

6. Final work of restoration left up to the Body of Christ--the many-membered son.

 2. Heb. 2:10. AFor it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory...@
 3. Is 53:8. AWho shall declare his generation?@
 1. He was cut off out of the land of the living.
 2. When thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin.
 1. He shall see his seed.
 2. He shall prolong his days.
 3. His seed is perpetuation of his generation or his namesake in the earth.
 4. Continuation of his ministry.
 5. Satan should tremble as much at Body of Christ as he did Christ.
